Our grounds are landscaped so that the whole of Teglan is completely accessible to anglers with disabilities. The paths around the lakes are level and surfaced, so that someone in a non-motorized wheelchair can get around with ease.



Using Teglan's specially designed skiff, the most profoundly disabled who are unable to cast, can be rowed out to drop a line and participate, along with their able bodied friends on the banks.

On shore, each peg is surfaced, over 6ft wide and stopped off with a wooden board to protect wheelchair users from an early bath!

Even our new clean kitchen and toilets have been built to give full access for all our clients.

It is said that Teglan is probably the best, if not the only completely accessible fishery in the country and to further our guiding principle of equality, owners Mark and David Owen are the mid-Wales Managers for the British Disabled Angling Association.

THE TOP LAKE

The larger and deeper of our lakes, in this spring fed 1¼ acre stretch you will find mostly Carp. In fact, eight sub-species including Koi and Crucians provide a good variety with 30lb Ghostie's waiting for the more adventurous. However, the variety of weights across all the species; green and golden Tench to about 4lb, Roach, Rudd and few Golden Orfe makes Teglan the preferred choice for both Novice and Master angler alike.

With an average depth of five feet, our Top Lake in fact drops to a 12 foot depth on the northern pegs.

THE RIVER LAKE

With it's long peninsula, our 1½ acre "match" lake is properly stocked with 12,000 fish up to 4lb consisting of Tench, Carp, Roach, Rudd and skimmer Bream, though the odd larger fish has been known to provide the occasional surprise!



Created in late 2002 to create a lake for all, whether top match style fishing, family fishing or just fishing at a venue where fish are guaranteed all year, the Teglan River Lake never fails to impress.

RIVER AERON

Teglan also offers you the chance to fish for wild Trout and Migratory fish in a stretch of the Aeron, which borders the Lower Lake. This supplementary facility is included free of charge to ticket holders.

DEMAND THE BEST

When combined, our facility provides some 5 acres of prime coarse fishing. Regular tending keeps them weed-free, and we carefully cultivate bank-side beds of rushes to attract foraging fish close in.

Our Carp have bred in Teglan for 5 years producing a very distinctive home bred hard fighting Carp.

To augment and enhance our particularly enviable surroundings we have landscaped the fishery with many unusual and beautiful trees together with ornamental grasses, shrubs and bamboo, all thoughtfully placed to provide shelter from wind and enhance your fishing experience.
